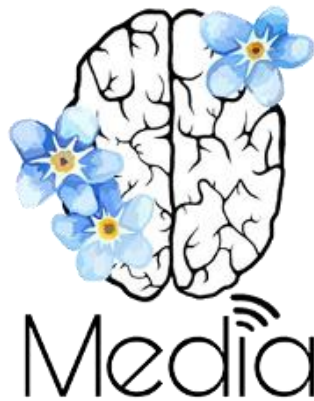


DEEPNESS DEMENTIA

1in100/600 Sheffield Dementia Conference

At Victoria Hall, Sheffield on the 20th and 21st March 2023

The conference is organised by Deepness Dementia Media (Deepness Ltd), a non-profit organization, run by people living with Dementia for people living with Dementia in association with Sheffield City Council.

The Conference

The theme of the two-day Conference is the ***Unconscious Bias of Dementia***

The Conference will comprise of 3 main sessions, 2 on day 1 and 1 on day 2

Each session will be followed by roundtable discussions with a note taker at each table

Those notes will form the basis of a report that Deepness Dementia Media will present to the Scottish, Welsh, Northern Ireland and Westminster Governments, the WHO Department of Mental Health and Substance Use - Brain Health Unit, and UN CRPD Committee

This report will also provide evidence for a fuller report that will be provided to the United Nations Special Rapporteur on Disability Mr. Gerard Quinn when he undertakes the delayed five yearly investigation into the UKs implementation of the UN CRPD in 2024.

Accessibility

Victoria Hall is an accessible venue and has a Quiet Room for those that may need a quiet space during the Conference.

There is a drop off point at the entrance to Victoria Hall and a Multi-Story Car Park over the road and limited Blue Badge parking on the same street.

There will be Students and Volunteers available during the Conference to offer assistance

There are regular Buses in and around the City and the Railway Station is about 15 minutes away and Trams about 5 minutes' walk,

There is a hill from the Railway Station to the Venue, so you may choose to use a taxi from the station

Food, Drink & Dietary Requirements.

Refreshments will be provided during the morning and afternoon breaks, with food and Refreshments being provided during the Lunch Breaks

Accommodation

There is limited Hotel accommodation that includes Breakfast and Evening Meal at £100 per night **non-refundable**

Priority will be given firstly to those with mobility challenges and then those who live more than 60 miles from Sheffield

You will be asked if you require any assistance when registering.

Please note the support is usually an unpaid carer and like professionals will be asked to listen not speak, unless the person they are with has aphasia and communicates with them what they want shared

Registration includes refreshments which will be provided during the morning and afternoon breaks, with food and refreshments being provided during the Lunch Breaks

Deepness Ltd have a Safeguarding Officer who will be present at the Conference and along with at least 1 Volunteer will be staying overnight at the Hotel

The Conference focuses on the lived experience of Dementia with professionals attending as observers who will have their opportunity to explore the topics and express their views at the final Conference session
